9. **REAL ESTATE**

The next item was the approval to select an Architect and a Construction Manager to design and construct the Integrative Biology and Genomic Medicine Institute (IBGMI) in Camden. The IBGMI is one of five projects cited for funding by the Legislature as part of the State's stem cell research initiative. Tentative plans call for an 80,000 to 100,000 sf facility to be developed adjacent to the proposed UMDNJ Academic Research Building in downtown Camden, at a cost of approximately \$50 million.
